BYLAW 2005-09

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373.
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guility of an offence and liable on summary conviction;
 - a) in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000.00 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500.00 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b) in the case of corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000.00 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500.00 for each day during which the offence continues.
- **5.** Bylaw No. 9303 is hereby repealed.
- 6. This Bylaw shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 2006.
